# MATT 12:33-37 NRSV

### ♦ A Tree and Its Fruit

- ♦ 33 "Either make the tree good, and its fruit good; or make the tree bad, and its fruit bad; for the tree is known by its fruit.
- ♦ 34 You brood of vipers! How can you speak good things, when you are evil? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.
- ♦ 35 The good person brings good things out of a good *treasure*, and the evil person brings evil things out of an evil *treasure*.
- ♦ 37 for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

#### **HELPS Word-studies**

2344 *thēsaurós* (from 5087 /*títhēmi*, "to put, set") – properly, *stored-up treasure* (riches); (figuratively) a *storehouse of treasure*, including (treasured) thoughts *stored up* in the heart and mind.

[2344 (*thēsaurós*) is the root the English term "*thesaurus*" which refers to a "storehouse (treasure) of synonyms." 2344 (*thēsaurós*) is literally "a receptacle for valuables").]

# Is your storehouse pleasing to God?

- ♦ It's apart of your character
- What you reap you sow
  - ♦ Good treasure vs. bad treasure
  - ♦ Galatians 6:7-8 (MSG)
    - Son't be misled: No one makes a fool of God. What a person plants, he will harvest. The person who plants selfishness, ignoring the needs of others—ignoring God!—harvests a crop of weeds. All he'll have to show for his life is weeds! But the one who plants in response to God, letting God's Spirit do the growth work in him, harvests a crop of real life, eternal life.

## What's in your wallet (storehouse)?



- ♦ Interests what you decide to focus on
- Experiences things that have or haven't happened in life
- Time how much time you allocate to interests
- Resources capital/effort to develop acquire interests

# Good Treasure is Important

- What people see from you, they'll believe about you and God.
  - ♦ If we love on people they'll see love from God..
  - ♦ If we forgive and heal we can help others receive the same
  - $\diamond$  When we give others are impacted by the gift
- This comes from the "good treasures" and valuables in the storehouses of our heart
- The things that are "central to our character"

♦ How can we build up a good treasure?



# Good Treasure

### ♦ Real Estate

- Decide to Invest, Gather Resources, Be Disciplined, Take Action
- Suilding up a storehouse of "good treasure"
  - Invest/Take interest accept Christ, ask Holy Spirit to Guide, and decide to invest in good treasure
  - ♦ Get Resources
    - Learn (bible study, ask questions, attend services, accountability partners)

### ♦ Put Time In

- Be disciplined/consistent, develop a habit/routine to learn and spend time with God
  - ♦ Small deposits compound overtime
- ♦ Take Action
  - ♦ Get experience, God wants to use you
  - Look for/don't run from opportunities to apply what you've learned in your life
  - Reflect on interactions/experiences even when you are afraid to step up

Matt 12:34 "....For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks".

- Righteousness is important to God and a central attribute
  - ♦ So its important to us!
  - ♦ Can we earn it, no
    - Sut we can invest in our Spirit with good treasure
